At first sight: I'm completely impressed with Oeuffice's penchant for reimagining the classics: They manage to create sculptural works of art that are equally functional and versatile. On composition: It's against this backdrop that the stools prove their inherent duality. They feel natural against the exposed brick but would also easily hold their own in both a formal or contemporary setting. As far as design goes... Italy really has no limits. These stools resonate with the country's influential style in part because of the simple application of elegant, timeless materials; the Cipollino Apuano marble is super-sleek, the travertine is very porous, and the Rosa Perlino marble is full of movement. Each element is independently unassuming, but in union, striking works of art are born. Lasting impression: Refined, sculptural, bold, fresh and playful.
